Middle and high school art students are invited to submit original artwork for the cover of GCISD's holiday greeting card. The holiday card is sent out by Superintendent Kay Waggoner and the Board of Trustees to community leaders, area businesses, organizations and neighboring school districts.

The art for the cover will be selected by a group of District employees and the Superintendent on the basis of originality, theme, use of colors and overall design. All submissions will be displayed in The Gallery in the Administration Building throughout December.

The artist whose work is selected for the GCISD Holiday Greeting Card will receive a \$25 gift card to Target, 10 greeting cards with his/her art on the cover and recognition at a Board of Trustees meeting. The art will be featured on the District's website and in other publicity about the contest.

Entry rules/guidelines:

- Submit only one entry per student.
- General winter themes should be used and artwork should reflect our diverse community which celebrates a variety of holidays.
- Artwork size should be 5 ½ x 8 ½ or 8 ½ x 11.
- Media should be easy to scan and reproduce.
- Submit art with the entry/parental permission form fastened securely to the back. Properly labeled entries will be returned to art teachers in January.
- Submit entry to your art teacher or drop it off at the reception desk of the Administration building, 8-4:30 p.m., M-Th, 8-4, Friday.
- Deadline for submission – Friday, Nov. 9, 4 p.m.
